Notice of Intention to ImProve Street in Tillamook City.

Notice is hereby given to all whom it may concern that the Common Council of Tillamook City, Oregon, did, on the 20th day of June, 20, 1917, adopt a resolution for the improvement of a street, in words, yetters and figures as follows, to-wit:

Resolution and Notice of Intention to Improve a Certain Street in Tillamook City, Oregon.

Be it resolved, That the Common Council of Tillamook City, Oregon, leems it expedient and hereby delares its intention to improve the ollowing street in said city, to-wit: Miller Avenue from the South side

of Third Street to the north side of Fifth Street by establishing the grade of said street, by grading the same to proper grade, by rolling the roadway thereof, and by laying thereon a concrete roadway 24 feet in width, and 6 inches in thickness, and by building curbs, catche basins and laying drain pipes together with inlets and contions, and making provisions for the necessary surface drainage of said street, with all the appurtenances

All of said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter, resolutions and ordinances of Tillamook City, and in accordance with plans and specifications and estimates of work thereof made and prepared by the City Engineer of Tillamook City, and filed in the office of the City Recorder of said city. All of said improvements to be made at the expense of the property, and all thereof adjacent thereto and especially benefitted by said improvements within the limits of said district established and defined by this reso-
