

Notice of Hearing on Petition To Form Drainage District.

In the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Tillamook County.

Notice is hereby given that hearing on the following petition will be held at the Court House in the City of Tillamook, County of Tillamook, State of Oregon, on the First day of May, 1918, for the purpose of determining whether the prayer of said petition shall be granted.

All persons owning or claiming an interest in lands described in said petition are hereby notified to appear at said place on said date and show cause, if any there be, why the prayer in said petition should not be granted.

The undersigned, being the owners of more than fifty per cent of the land in Tillamook County, Oregon, hereinafter described, do hereby petition your Honorable Body and pray that you cause to be organized and formed, a drainage district for the purpose of having said lands reclaimed and protected in the manner herein set forth from the effects of water, for sanitary and agricultural purposes and for the benefit and welfare of the public, and for the public utility and benefit.

For the purpose of this petition we state the following facts, as required by Chapter 340 of the General Laws of Oregon for the year 1915.

1. The name proposed for the district which is herein prayed for is the South Prairie Drainage District.

2. The boundary lines of the proposed district are as follows.

Beginning at a point on the East bank of the Tillamook river, where the sixteenth section line running east and west through the North half of Section 6 in Township 2, south of range 9, West of Willamette Meridian intersects said river; thence in a southerly direction along the bank of said river to the point where quarter section line running East and West through Section 7 intersects said river; thence East along said quarter section line to the section line between sections 7 and 8; thence north along said section line to the southwest corner of lot 1, of Section 8; thence East to the South East corner of Lot 1 of Section 8; thence North along the sixteenth section line running North and South through the West half of sections 8 and 5 to the quarter section line running East and West through section 5; thence West along said line to the sixteenth section line running North and South through the East half of Section 6; thence North along said sixteenth section line to the sixteenth section line running East and West through the North half of section 6; thence West along said sixteenth section line to the place of beginning.

3. The total acreage included in said proposed district is 728.96 acres.

4. The name of the owners of land in said district as shown by the records of Tillamook County, Oregon, and acreage owned by each of said owners is as follows:

5. The proposed reclamation and protection of said lands is for sanitary and agricultural purposes, and such proposed reclamation and protection will be conducive to the public health and welfare, and of public utility and benefit.

6. All of said lands included in said proposed district are properly included herein, and will be beneficially affected by the operation of the proposed district.

7. The benefits of such proposed reclamation and protection will exceed the damage to be done, and the best interests of the land included, and of the owners thereof as a whole, and of the public at large will be promoted by the formation and proposed operation of such district.

8. The formation of a drainage district under the provisions of Chapter 340 of the General Laws of Oregon for 1915, under the provisions of which this petition is presented, is a proper district.

9. The proposed plan for the reclamation and protection of the property in the proposed district includes the construction of such dykes and tide gates along the banks of the Tillamook river, in the region of the South Prairie Slough, as are necessary to protect the lands of the district from the tide and to construct such ditches as are necessary to give each property owner a drainage outlet. This plan is only general, the detailed plan to be worked out by the Chief Engineer and Supervisors.

10. The signers of this petition agree that they will pay any and all expenses incurred, and any tax or taxes that may be levied against their respective lands for the purpose of paying the expenses of organizing,

or attempting to organize the proposed district, such expense to be taxed against the signers in proportion to the number of acres owned by them and affected by the proposed drainage district.

11. Wherefore, your petitioners pray that the lands described herein, or such thereof as may be found by the Court to be properly included in the proposed district, either permanently or until further investigation and surveys may permit elimination, shall be declared organized into a drainage district under the provisions of Chapter 340 hereinafter referred to.

To Whom It May Concern:

Whereas, the State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners of the State of Oregon has propagated and stocked and is propagating and stocking the waters of Tillamook Bay and its tributaries in Tillamook County, State of Oregon, with salmon and other food fish, and;

Whereas, said Tillamook Bay and its tributaries are frequented by salmon and other food fish, and for the purpose of protecting the same, the said Board of Fish and Game Commissioners has decided to close certain of the tributaries of Tillamook Bay, as follows, to-wit: Hoquarton Slough above a point on said slough where the quarter section line running north and south through the center of sections 24 and 25, T. 1 S., R. 10 West, Willamette Meridian crosses said slough; and also that portion of said slough between a point 100 ft. above the uppermost portion of the mouth of Stillwell Ditch and a point 100 feet below the lowermost portion of the mouth of said

Stillwell Ditch; and also that portion of said slough between a point 100 ft. above the uppermost portion of the mouth of the Old or North Fork of Trask River and a point 100 ft. below the lowermost portion of the mouth of the Old or North Fork of Trask River; and also all that portion of the Tillamook River above a point thereon where the township line running north and south between Ranges 9 and 10 West of the Willamette Meridian crosses the Tillamook river; and also the whole of Trask River, including the main river and all its branches, forks and tributaries, and also that portion or branch thereof which empties into Hoquarton Slough and is commonly known as "Stillwell Ditch," all being in Tillamook County, State of Oregon, are, and each and all of them are, hereby closed to fishing of any kind, except with hook and line commonly called angling, for salmon and other food fish, from and after the first day of April, 1918, until said tributaries of said Tillamook Bay are again opened to salmon and other food fish fishing herein prohibited as provided for by Section 5316 L. O. L., as amended by Chapter 400 of the General Laws of Oregon, for 1917.

And it shall be unlawful to fish for, or take or catch salmon or other food fish in any of the said waters so closed from and after the 1st day of April, 1918, and any and all persons violating the provisions of this notice will be prosecuted as by law provided.
