Vrooman, former Assistant Secretary of Agriculture, in an address at Chicago, recently declared his opposition to the Plumb plan of railroad operation and his denial of the statement by Glenn E. Plumb. author of the plan, that labor, capital and the public are equal. Mr. Vrooman made the point that the public is superior to either labor or capital-that the public is greater than any of its parts. Mr. Vrooman's point is well taken. Labor and capital may be equal in their importance, but the public is greater than either or both by reason of the fact that it includes both of them in conjunction with every other element of human endeavor in an organized society.
