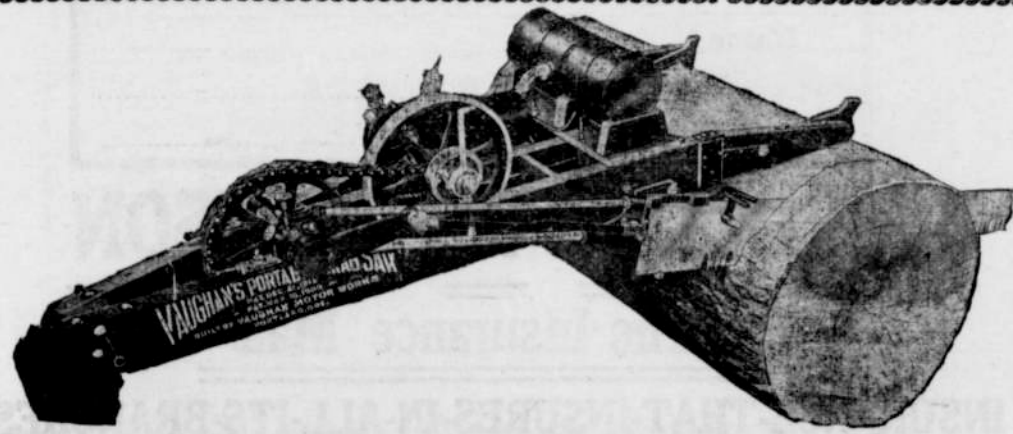

passage and publication of this ordinance. SECTION 3: The privilege hereby granted is subject to the following provision: Provided that no storage tank or tanks, or gasoline in cases, shall be erected, maintained, stored or kept on said property under the provisions of this ordinance nearer than 100 feet to any building now erected or existing in Tillamook City, unless the consent of the owner or owners of any such building or buildings be first obtained in writing, and provided further that if said Union Oil Company shall at any time so conduct its said business on said property that the same shall become a menace to the lives or property of Tillamook City, this ordinance shall thereupon become null and void.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be published in the Tillamook Headlight and Tillamook Herald, weekly newspapers published in Tillamook City, Oregon, for not less than one issue of each said papers, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the expiration of 30 days after the date of such publication. Ordinance No. 389 was read for the first time at 8:32 P. M. March 22, 1920. A motion was made, seconded and carried that the Ordinance pass to the second reading by title only and was so read at 8:34 P. M. Motion was made and seconded that the ordinance pass to the third reading on this date and upon the roll being called, the vote resulted as follows: Johnson, Aye; Moulton, Aye; Alderman, Aye; Harris, Aye; Total, Ayes, 4; Noes, 0; Absent, 1. Whereupon the ordinance was read for the third time upon this its date of introduction being then and there before the open Council upon the question, "Shall the Ordinance pass?" upon the roll being called the vote resulted as follows: Johnson, Aye; Moulton, Aye; Alderman, Aye; Harris, Aye; Total, Ayes, 4; Noes, 0; Absent, 1. Whereupon the ordinance was declared duly passed at 8:40 P. M. this 22nd day of March, 1920.
