Stock Breeders Pass Resolutions.

We, your committee, appointed by the various breeder's organizations for the purpose of making suggestions for the improvement and betterments for future Fairs and Live Stock Exhibitions and Milking Contests, beg leave to submit the following in Resolutions for your earnest consideration:

First—Whereas, the Seventh Annual County Fair is now passing into history of the development of Tillamook county; and whereas, success, prosperity and good-will has been so much in evidence in this and past Fairs; brought about by the untiring efforts and much unthankful work of the Board of Directors and Official heads and for which service

very little general appreciation has been manifested; be it hereby Resolved, that a unanimous vote of thanks be given the collective management of the Tillamook County Fair for their loyal and hard work, for the achievement of the results obtained in our interests.

Second, whereas, Tillamook county will be much benefitted as a whole and our people brought together in solving various problems, in the high calling in promoting industry, production of Tillamook's famous cheese, pure bred cattle—animal husbandry and soil fertility, and Whereas, it is so essential to our future well-being, it is hereby Resolved, that the various interests of Tillamook county approve of perpetuating future County Fairs; supporting our various officials in furthering and promoting future County Fairs as a permanent feature of our

civic and community life. Third, Whereas, the County Court of Tillamook and the Fair Directors have been authorized by the voters of Tillamook county to acquire a suitable tract for a Fair ground, and Whereas, the matter of finance will be submitted to the voters at the November election for their further approval by their votes, to provide for purchasing Fair grounds, be it Resolved, that we, your committee approve, and recommend to all voters of Tillamook county, that they give this matter their favorable consideration and vote for the same at the November election.

Fourth, whereas, it is so essential to the future of the Live Stock industry, and associated productions; that the future County Fairs be put on a High Efficiency Basis, and Whereas, it will become necessary in the near future—in fact before another year rolls round—that Tillamook county, have suitable buildings and conveniences at the new Fair Ground; and Whereas, the problems confronting the present rules of management of the Fairs of the future, together with the multitudinous details necessary to be worked out to the best advantage; and believing that the best results can be obtained by placing the responsibility of General Management in the control of some one person specially delegated and qualified, be it, Resolved, that the Fair Board secure the services of an efficiency management in one superintendent to carry forward all the details necessary to secure the best results: Fifth, Whereas it is planned to erect suitable housing or Fair buildings on the County grounds, and Whereas, plans have been submitted

which are not deemed by those who have seen them to be advisable, in-as-much as the buildings would be widely detached and scattered over the tract of land and Whereas, the weather conditions to be provided against in this county has fully demonstrated the advisability of having our Fair Exhibits housed and displayed to the best advantage; and Whereas, after due consideration given this matter, it is—Resolved, that the Fair Management in making the building improvements for housing the future Fairs, be somewhat along the line of plans of the Pacific International Live Stock Exposition Building in Portland; which would be the most desirable in all of its appointments; and be it further Resolved, that the Pure Bred Live Stock Breeders and their associates, recommend to the County Fair Board

that such improvement be taken with the end in view of having the same completed by the 1921 Fair. Sixth—Whereas, millions of dollars are now being produced in Tillamook famous cheese; and whereas, more millions of dollars brought into the county for the purchase of and sales of Tillamook Pure Bred Cattle, and whereas, the future in this respect is not visionary, but is real; and whereas, the principle industries of this county can be best brought about by a full co-operation for the quick advancement of the best inter-generations to come, be it resolved that the sum of \$25,000.00 per annum be provided in the County Budget of expenditures for the improvement of the Tillamook County Fair Grounds, keeping in view the fact that this is to be a permanent institution for the development of our resources.
