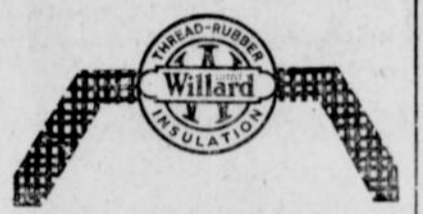
NOTICE OF SALE FOR DELINQUENT STREET IMPROVEMENT ASSESSMENTS.
