RESULTS OF APRIL COW TEST

The official cow test for April has been completed and the report follows: Secretary, Paul Fitzpatrick; Tester Peters & Hall. Average pounds of milk per cow, 1993. Average pounds of butterfat per cow, 44.72. Number of cows tested during month, 926. Number of cows producing over 40 pounds of fat, 373. Three high pure bred herds are: Owner, John Schild, 17 cows, 1565 av. pounds of milk each, 49.29 av. pounds of fat each; Homer Mason owner, 12 cows, 1000 lbs. av. milk per cow, 47.90 av. pounds of fat each. Three high grade herds are: Paul Fitzpatrick, owner, 12 cows, 1314 lbs. of milk each, 64.57 lbs. of fat each; Durrer Bros., owner 23 cows, 1461 lbs. of milk each, 64.29 lbs. of fat each; Clyde Kinnaman, owner, 12 cows, 1324 lbs. of milk each, 58.27 lbs. of fat each.

High Pure bred cow, Jollie. Owner, Neilson Eros, Tillamook, Breed Holstein, age 7, 3 months since fresh, Months milk record, 2769 lbs., fat 102.12 lbs. High grade cow, Mollie, Louis Weber, Tillamook, owner, Breed G. Jersey, Age 8, 1 month since fresh, months milk record 2169 lbs., fat 116.69 lbs. What improvement in way of weeding out unprofitable cows, increasing production, buying of pure bred bulls, better feeding, cooperative buying of feeds, checking on poor separators, etc. have been accomplished. Three unprofitable cows have been disposed of. Several bulls and a number of cows and heifers were purchased at a sale of outside Jerseys. Three milking machines installed, one discarded.
