AMERICAN LEGION NOTES Warrant for the arrest of Roger Baldwin, founder of the American Civil Liberties Union, has been sworn out by Major Milton D. Campbell, acting for the American Legion in Cincinnati, O., on a charge that Baldwin violated the state law in "openly advocating revolution."
