

FIRE DESTROYS BARN AND CONTENTS

Total Loss - - \$6,000

Total Insurance \$2,000

Sunday forenoon, Oct. 16, the large dairy barn, over 100 tons of hay, milking machinery and a large amount of equipment on the farm of H. F. Goodspeed was burned to the ground. The total loss amounts to about \$6,000 with only \$2,000 insurance.
