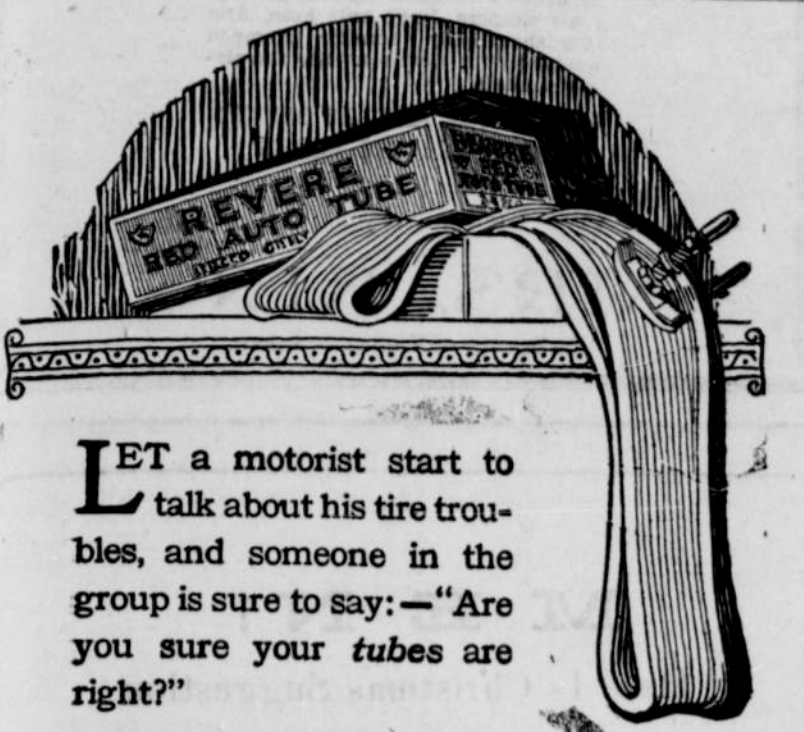

**NOTICE**  
 To whom it may concern:  
 Whereas the State Game Commission of the State of Oregon is desirous of protecting the wild waterfowl inhabiting and using Netarts Bay in Tillamook county, state of Oregon:

Therefore, by authority of law vested in said State Game Commission of the state of Oregon, under Section 3, Chapter 56, Laws of 1921 notice is hereby given that the waters of Netarts Bay in Tillamook county, state of Oregon, are closed to hunting and shooting of all kinds on and after the date of this order, until said Netarts Bay in Tillamook county, state of Oregon, is again reopened to hunting and shooting by order of the State Game Commission of the state of Oregon.

And it is and shall be unlawful for any person or persons at any time to use any sink boat, sink box, scow, raft, row boat, sail boat, scow, raft or any boat propelled by mechanical power on Netarts Bay in Tillamook county, state of Oregon, for the purpose of taking, disturbing, harrying, shooting at, or killing any of the wild waterfowl thereon.

Any and all persons whosoever using any sink boat, sink box, row boat, sail boat, scow, raft or any boat propelled by mechanical power on Netarts Bay in Tillamook county, state of Oregon, for the purpose of taking, disturbing, harrying, shooting at, or killing any of the wild waterfowl thereon, on and after the date of this order, will be prosecuted as by statute provided.

You are further notified that said Charles F.
