ORDINANCE NO. 418

An Ordinance entitled an Ordinance providing for the regulation, taxing and licensing of certain per sons, occupations and trades, providing a penalty for a violation thereof, repealing Ordinance No.'s 200, 286, 299, and declaring an emerg-

The people of Tillamook City do

Section 1: It is hereby made unlawful, except as hereinafter providtion to sell or dispose of or take or-ed, for any person, firm or corporaders for the future sale and or delivery of any goods, wares or mer chandise within the corporate limit of Tillamook City, unless said person, firm or corporation shall have first secured a license from the City

Recorder, as herein provided. Section 2. This Ordinance shall not apply to any bona fide merchant of Tillamook county who disposes or seeks to dispose of any product raised by him upon his own prop-erty or any property held by him

Section 3. This ordinance shall not apply to any bona fide merihant within the corporate limits of Tillamook city, who is a bona fide resi-

Section 4: This Ordinance shall not apply to traveling salesmen en-gaging in taking orders from bona fide merchants

Section 5: Any person, firm corporation proposing to sell or disose of goods, wares or merchandise, or disposing of same, except a here-inafter provided, shall first secure from the City Recorder, as hereinbefore provided a license, and for said license shall pay to the City Re-corder the sum of \$5 per day or frac tion thereof per individual for said

Any person, firm or corporation riolating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100. or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than five nor more than inirty days, or both such fine and mprisonment, provided that in the default of the payment of the fine imposed hereunder, said party shall be imprisoned in the City Jail at the

rate of one day for each \$2 of said

Section 6: Whereas, many per sons are selling and peddling goods and merchandise in Tillamook City, health and safety of said City. emergency is hereby declared to ex-ist and this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon its approval by the Mayor.


