### Order Seed Corn Now

C. Experiment Station.

### Spray Material Calculated

In figuring the amount of spray materials needed allow 200 gallons of dilute spray mixture for each acre of trees 9 to 12 years old. The average dilution of winter strength lime-sulfur is 12 to 100, hence to find out the gallons of stock solution needed multiply the number of acres by 24 to get an approximate estimate. For the delayed dormant spray multiply by 7. About four pounds of arsenate of lead per acre are needed and one should figure on making four applications a year. Thus, multiplying the acres by 16 will give a good estimate.—O. A. C. Experiment Station.

Other fertilizers may be applied after plowing, but as soon afterwards as possible in order to allow the materials to go into solution in time to be effective for the first crop.
