

- 5. The same object can be named but once. This does not preclude however the naming of an object which is a part of another object.
- 6. Only such compound words which by long usage have become, and in the dictionary are given, as one word, can be used. Hyphenated words and words that appear in the dictionary as two words are not to be considered.
- 7 The word may be given in the singular or plural form but if the one is used the other can not be.
- 8 The first prize will be awarded to the contestant whoe answer has the largest and nearest corrct list of objects found in the picture which begin with the letter "B", second prize to the next nearest correct, etc. Neatness and penmanship will not be taken into consideration, but every centestart should be careful about the spelling so that no mistal will be made.
