In the name of the State of Oregon you are hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above court and cause on or before six weeks from the date of the first publication of this summons, and should you fail to appear and file answer or otherwise appear in said cause within said time, plaintiff will apply to the above named Court for the relief prayed for against you in the complaint, which is that plaintiff have judgment against the defendant J.
