of January, 1921, and recorded in the Mortgage Records of Tillamook County, Oregon, in Book 8, page 137.

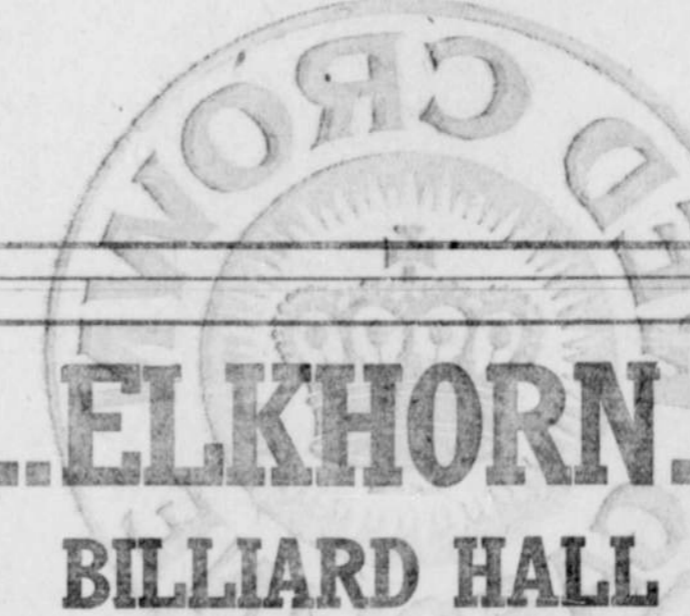
