**JUSTICE DISCARDED**  
What might be considered one of the greatest travesties on justice in the state of Oregon was recently accomplished at Dallas in the trial of Philip Warren for the murder of Glen Price.

A jury, composed of "twelve good men, and true," heard the case, and supposed to have sifted the evidence and turned the murderer loose. It was a case of practically self-concealed murder.

Evidently, this jury considered that when a drunken Indian kills a peace officer in resisting arrest it constitutes justifiable homicide.

Such a soft headed idea of justice pays a premium on murder.
