SUMMONS

In the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Tillamook Neetoca Valley Bank, a banking corporation, plaintiff.

D. W. Snyder and Maude Snyder, husband and wife, Tillamook County Bank, a banking corporation, and Al Boon, Defendants.

To D. W. Snyder and Maude Snyder, husband and wife, defendants above named:

In the name of the State of Oregon, you are hereby required to appear and answer to the complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit, in the above entitled Court, on or before the 1st day of April, 1923, and if you fail so to appear or answer, for want thereof, plaintiff will apply to said Court for the relief prayed for in plaintiff's complaint herein, to-wit:

First: That plaintiff have and recover from the defendants, D. W. Snyder and Maude Snyder, together with interest at the rate of 7 per cent per annum from the 30th day of April, 1921, and for the further sum of \$100.00 attorney's fees and its costs and disbursements incurred herein.

Second: Adjudging and decreeing that plaintiff's mortgage be a first, valid and subsisting lien upon the real property hereinbefore described, and provided that said mortgage be foreclosed and that the said real property be sold in the manner provided by law for the sale of real property upon execution, and that the proceeds of such sale be applied to the payment of the costs and disbursements of this suit and the expenses of sale of said real property; to the payment of plaintiff in the sum of \$500.00 with interest thereon at the rate of 7 per cent per annum from the 30th day of April, 1921; to the payment of plaintiff in the sum of \$100.00 attorney's fees, and that the balance, if any, be applied as the Court may direct.

Third: That all defendants, and each of them, and all persons claiming or seeking to claim said real property or any part thereof thru or under them or either of them, be forever barred and foreclosed of any lien, claim, title, interest or equity therein or thereto, except the statutory right of redemption.

Fourth: That plaintiff have judgment and execution against defendants, D. W. Snyder and Maude Snyder, for any deficiency which may remain after applying all of the proceeds of the sale of the said real premises described in said mortgage to the satisfaction of the indebtedness to plaintiff, and that plaintiff or any other party to this suit may become a purchaser at said sale, and that the purchaser be let into possession of said premises, and that the Sheriff of Tillamook County, Oregon, at the proper time execute a deed to such purchaser, and that plaintiff may have such other and further relief in the premises as to the Court may seem just and equitable.
