A correspondent asks this paper to define a "sheik". All right here goes: Originally a sheik was or is a chief of an Arab tribe, who affects gaudy clothing.

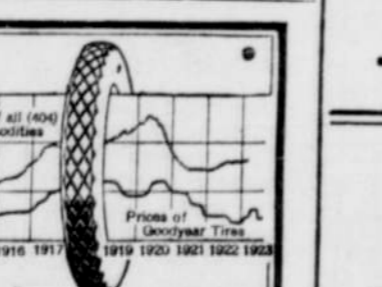
The newspapers state that the new president is "friendly to Mexico." Just why this government has failed to recognize the Mexican republic and President Obregon, is something of a mystery.

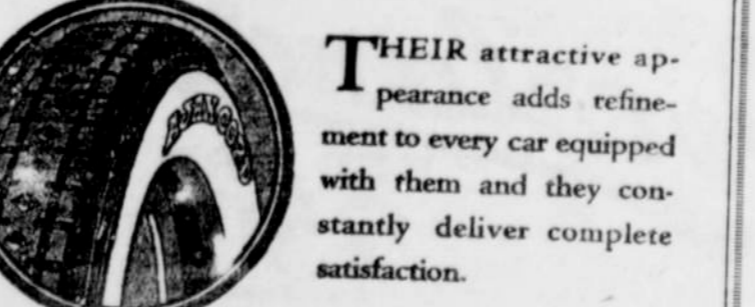

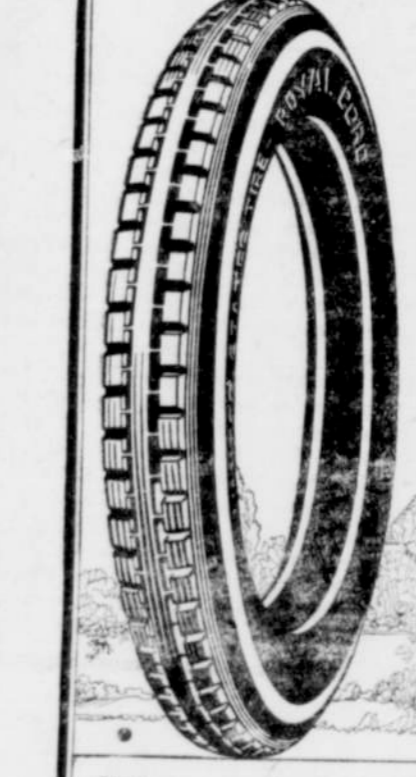
