Section 43. Section 47. Shipment of Motor Vehicles from State.-It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to ship on any ocean going vessels any motor vehicle out of the state of Oregon by vessel, boat or by any other character of water craft, without first obtained a written permit at the point of shipment, as hereinafter provided. In cities of 5,000 or more inhabitants, such permit shall be issued by the chief of police, or other corresponding official, and in cities or towns having a population of less than 5,000 or in other political subdivisions of the state, such permit shall be issued by the sheriff of the county having jurisdiction. 
