WRITER COMPLIMENTS HABERLACH

Hyman Cohen of the Portland Journal this week pays a high compliment to Carl Haberlach, manager of the Tillamook Creamery association in an article in the market columns of that paper. We quote:

"The need of experts has been shown for several years, but the present situation is most serious. Oregon fruit and produce men need another Carl Haberlach. They need someone of the caliber of the Tillamook man, who during periods of depressed prices took the dairy industry of that section in hand and forced it to become profitable.

When Haberlach took over the Tillamook dairy association, the cheese industry was practically bankrupt. By dint of knowledge of marketing conditions and by a policy of honest dealing with the public and the trade, the former bankrupt industry was not only placed upon its feet, but today is the marvel of the entire world. Another Haberlach is the need. Haberlach was strong enough to force the Tillamook cheese makers to do his bidding. He forced them to put out a standard article and to continue its quality. He secured the confidence of the trade. The result is today that

Tillamook cheese is the highest priced in the world for similar variety.

Oregon fruit and vegetable producers need another Haberlach. The industries are in just as serious condition as were the Tillamook dairymen when timely help came to their air."

\$300,000 SPENT FOR AUTOS

Tillamook county annually spends \$300,000 for automobiles, that is, new ones. On what is believed to be reliable authority it is learned that \$25,000 is spent in the county every month for new automobiles. Multiply that amount by twelve and one has a total of \$300,000 as the annual expenditure for those machines.

right here in your own town, will bear me out. Further, I am going to tell you why insurance in your town is decreasing in premium rates. Your graded streets, which allow speedy access of fire engines to a fire, is one cause. You have a wide-awake fire organization here, which has one of the finest records in the state for stopping fires, which is another reason. We keep posted on all these things. We have to; and it pays every property owner in the town to stand by your fire fighters. If you did not have such an efficient

fire fighting organization here, surely, your rates on business and dwelling risks would be higher. Another reason for the decline of rates is that you are building a better class of buildings, and fewer old frame buildings. You have fine fire apparatus, and a mighty fine organization of fire fighters, and you ought to be glad that you have. Fire prevention is better than fire fighting. But when fires do occur, your paved streets allow the engine to be taken quickly to the incipient blaze and thus get action, which often saves a bad fire, and property."

"The better the conditions are to prevent and fight fire in a town, the lower you will find the rate of insurance."

FEED RATES LOWERED

July, a certain amount of the mead-

ows would be cut if the cows could not eat all the hay growing during those months.

The reduction from Haynes to Tillamook is \$3.00 a ton, from Redmond to Marshfield, \$3.60 a ton, from Hermiston to Yaquina, \$2.80 a ton, and from Hermiston to Marshfield, \$3.30 a ton. In order to meet the competition, which would naturally develop by the reduction in freight, the association is now selling its alfalfa hay out of the warehouse at \$22, but is unable to sell off cars at less than that as it is holding up all shipments until such time as the new rates go into effect. Prices on oat and vetch hay is \$29 out of the warehouse.

Commencing the first of the year price of corn will probably be \$39 the ton, or \$2 per 100 lbs., whether whole, cracked, or ground. The price of oats, a ton after that date, with middlings corn, and barley will probably be \$39 selling at \$30 the ton. Otherwise the feed list will be changed.

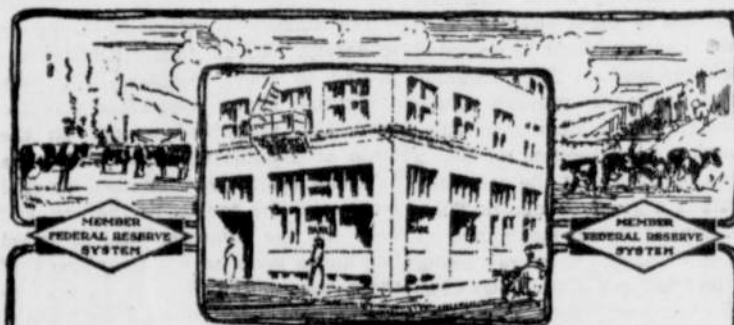
