RELIGIOUS DEBATE

Continued from last week

After all the falsehoods, perversions of fact, which Phelps stands convicted would it not seem absurd to follow his vagaries still further? He clamorously insists upon learning where in the Bible "we find proof that... fish eat meat." For his information, I would say that no such text is in existence. Few I imagine will deny that fish is not meat. If Phelps does, I let him have his own way in this instance. Catholics abstain from flesh on Friday to honor the death of Christ. As for the perpetual virginity of the Virgin Mary that she had no other children after her Divine Son, this is a matter of history rather than of scripture. The Bible itself expressly states that only a part of the things which Jesus said, or taught are recorded in the sacred book. The early church held firmly to this belief, as we learn from the condemnation of Helvidius in the 3rd century by the synods of Rome (A. D. 381) and Capua (A. D. 392). The Council of Lateran in A. D. 649 fully sanctioned this doctrine by an official decree. Indeed, Luther, Calvin, and Beza among the Reformers, besides many Protestant writers, deny as emphatically as any Catholic that the Blessed Virgin had other children than Christ. To determine, therefore, the meaning of the word brother or brethren in the Gospel texts, we take its meaning in Hebrew and according to the interpretation handed down by St. Jerome and St. Augustine and the other distinguished authorities; which that the father of James was Jesus (Cleophas) and his mother a relative of the Blessed Virgin, and his brothers, Jude, Joseph and Simon; the "brethren" of the Lord were therefore the cousins or near relatives of Jesus (Compare Matt xxvii. 61, xxviii. 1; Mark xv 40, 47, xvi. 7, and John xix 25). The fact is that the old testament, brother sister, brethren are applied to any relative or nephew (Gen. xiv 16, xiii. 8, xii. 14, Gen. xxix, 15), husband (Gen. iv. 9), one of the same tribe (Kings ix. 12), of the same people (Gen. ii. 21) an ally (Amos. i. 9), a friend (2 Kings i. 26) one of the same office. (3 Kings ix. 13).

WHAT WILL HONEST PERSONS THINK OF THE BRAZEN DECEIT OF HIS PREACHER MANIFESTED ABOUT THE SO-CALLED AFFIDAVIT. I am positive, and was so from the start, that Phelps is deliberating prevaricating when he claims having an affidavit stating that ex-governor Olcott was seen in the ranks of the K. of C. being initiated. Such an affidavit if existent, would be perjury. Phelps' excuse for not showing an affidavit was that he first wanted to ascertain scriptural text: imagine that brazen deceit. In turn I offered a dilemma: Either Phelps has not an affidavit and is deliberating lying, or he is using perjury to obtain his ends. Now Phelps comes back with this illuminating statement: "Readers will notice that Mr. Davey is half over the fence. First I was a liar, and did not have it. Now, I have it, but it is perjury. It is

now up to my opponents to prove that it is perjury." How in the world can I or anyone else prove that his document is perjury unless he offers it as evidence. But I do not think he can do even this; I still believe Phelps' statement is only a plain, simple lie. Certainly it is one or the other.

WOULD SANE PEOPLE THINK IT POSSIBLE FOR ANYONE TO GIVE UTTERANCE TO SUCH INSANE PRATTLE AS THIS: "If Rome did not fear England and America she would slaughter the Protestants in Ireland, Belgium and France tomorrow." This was the climax of another of his "unanswerable arguments" about the intolerance of the Catholic church. Whether such idiotic ramblings as this justify further comments, I leave to the kind reader of the Headlight to judge.

MUST NOT THE PEOPLE OF TILLAMOOK STAND AMAZED AT THE BLATANT AUDAACITY OF THIS PREACHER EXHIBITED IN HIS 37 LINES OF RAVINGS ABOUT SLAUGHTER, INQUISITIONS, etc? In mentioning Llorent, I was speaking about the Spanish Inquisition, saying "I charitably presume that you are ignorant of the fact that these anti-Catholic statistics" on the Spanish Inquisition, to which very likely you chiefly refer, are originally derived from an apostate named Llorent who admits that he burned all the records from which he claims to have taken all his figures. However, Mr. Phelps pretends that I said that all the records of all the strifes between Catholic and Protestants were destroyed by Llorent. He becomes fairly frantic indulging in this characteristic statement: "This is a fair sample of the fables, fairytales and taradiddle, that Roman Catholic priests and leaders try and cram down the laymen as history." On this subject of the persecutions of the Middle Ages, the following is again respectfully referred to the intelligent people of Tillamook. We do not deny that some Catholics, laymen and ecclesiastics, persecuted their opponents during the middle ages, when even Catholic rulers regarded heresy as a political crime, destructive of authority, government and right order. Therefore while we denounce those monarchs who used torture and inquisitions, we should remember that their aim usually was to stamp out civil wars and internal dissensions, within their own realms. Those were ages of severity and cruelty. Thank God, as far as Catholics are concerned, they have passed away forever. But is it fair to speak continually of the Huguenots, or the Spanish Inquisition, the abuses of which have been grossly exaggerated, ignoring the fact that Protestantism itself was propagated with a world-wide storm of persecution? In every country where the reformers became powerful, they persecuted most bitterly; e. g., in Germany England, Scotland, Denmark, Sweden, the Netherlands; Luther himself held that the Anabaptists should be burned; declared all measures against Catholics lawful and invoked the civil power against Carlstadt and the Zwinglians. Calvin burned Servetus for denying the Trinity and wrote a book in defense of the right of persecution.

In England the history of the penal laws of Henry VIII, Elizabeth, Edward VI, James I, Charles I, Cromwell, Charles II, is a tale of horrors, imprisonment, banishment, torture and death for those who insisted upon practicing the Catholic religion. Cranmer advocated persecution; both Ranke and Hume call Elizabeth's

High Commission a "Protestant Inquisition." The Scotch Parliament in 1560 declared death to Catholics. Archbishop Usher declared: "To give any toleration to Papists is a grievous sin." (See Neale's History of the Puritans, vol. 2 page 469). John Wesley at the time of the Gordon riots wrote: "They (Catholics) are not to be tolerated by any government, Protestant, Mohammedan or pagan," etc.

WHAT DO JUSTICE LOVING CITIZENS THINK ABOUT SUCH FIENDISH ANTI-CATHOLIC METHODS AS THIS: The homes for delinquent girls conducted by the saintly self-sacrificing sisters of the Good Shepherd, these are called "Hell's own sweatshops." Phelps was asked to take their institution here in Portland as a case in point; to consult various public officers who are constantly calling at and over-seeing the methods of that institution. But no, instead (1) he must pick out one pretended case in order to condemn them all. As if one said: A certain preacher is a falsifier and a thief therefore they are all the same. (2) He goes to Columbus, I suppose Ohio, the state is not given. (3) He fails to give the name of the paper; he only says "a Columbus newspaper." (4) He does not give any year, month, or day, only "a Columbus newspaper." (5) He fails to tell us how little children, orphans, waifs, and others got into a good Shepherd home, which is conducted for incorrigible and delinquent girls. After his insane statement, he concludes: "yes, visit and know for yourselves" etc. But that it what I have been asking this preacher to do right along; but there is no danger of him making an honest investigation and giving the public the benefit of it. He is deliberately falsifying and he knows it, and everyone else can see it, who is not carrying on a campaign of defamation against the Catholic church for the sake of the money or selfish ends attacked to it.

WHAT OF CROWLEY WHOM PHELPS BELIEVES AND QUOTES SO ARDENTLY? As for the man Crowley, I have no way of checking up his record in Ireland but I do know that since he was publicly communicated by Archbishop Feehan in Chicago, in 1901, or thereabouts, he has proven himself to be a shameless characterless creature whose likeness would fitly adorn any representative rogues' gallery.

HOW DOES THE PUBLIC REGARD THIS PERVERSE CLINGING TO FALSEHOOD? When it is clearly proven by all reliable history that Lincoln's assassin, Wilkes Booth (if anything) was an Anglican, that Garfield's assassin, Guiteau, was a disciple of Meedy and that McKinley's assassin, Czolgoz, was a rabid anarchist; what must be thought of iterating the same lie over and over Phelps and his type who keep on repeating. From all these instances, fair-minded readers can understand better the tactics which anti-Catholics so freely employ. For there is nothing original in Phelps' methods. He is only rehashing old falsehoods, hoary with age. But there is this much in his favor. He is using methods that have usually been money getters for the characterless and unscrupulous during the last half of three quarters of a century.
