The Oregon state game commission announced that it will pay additional bounties on certain predatory animals in addition to those now being paid by several counties of the state.

The state bounties referred to are \$25, cougar \$25, and wild cat \$3. Bounties must be presented to the clerk of the county in which the animal was killed and an affidavit of the killing forwarded to the game commission.

All wolf hides must be forwarded to the game commission for identification before the bounty is paid.

BOAT SCHOONER BURNS AT SEA

GRATE SHIP PICKS UP CAPTAIN FERGUSON AND WIFE Crew Is Rescued By Fire Patrol

Tillamook, Oregon, Nov. 24, 1924. Just off the coast of a seaside port a ten schooner sent out a call for help which was picked up by F. P. Ferguson, station. Captain Ferguson, master of the burning ship and his wife, after being adrift all night in a small boat was picked up by a steamer, blinded, by order of the captain, whom the crew called Buck Anderson, and set adrift again with his wife. He was picked up later by the Fire Patrol. Captain Ferguson, suffering untold agony stated that he had been separated from his wife, Jack Anderson taking her below while the crew set about torturing her.
