## Delaman and Dolan—The Demise of the Old Board Walk.

How our memory clings in fond recollection to the old landmarks, that formed a part of our youth. Who cannot remember the cheerful clatter made by the passers by along the antique and erratic board walk so prevalent in the generation just gone, and still existing with tenacious persistence in patches and spots, in the remotest sections of the town?
