FEW HENS LAY MANY EGGS

Just 1225 eggs in one year is the unofficial record of a pen of seven hens owned by the landscape gardener at the Oregon Agricultural College. The pen is from the best egg strain of the College-bred Barred Rocks. The hens had the run of a small orchard and were kept and fed under ordinary farm conditions. Heavy egg yields were made by them in the fall and early winter months, when eggs were selling at 30 to 50 cents a dozen. Had the year's crop been sold at market prices as it was gathered, it would probably have brought about 33 cents a dozen. The entire crop, more than 127 dozen, would have brought about \$41.35, which is \$6.85 a hen. The average cost of keeping is about \$1.45 per hen a year. This leaves a profit of \$4.50 on each hen annually.

Restoration To Entry Of Lands In National Forest.
