NEW TAX LAWS

In preparation of the assessment of the tax levied for the year 1915, the second payment of taxes will be due on Monday, March 5, 1915, at the post office at Tillamook, Oregon. The law will not allow the first of spring payment of taxes.

The legislature passed the bill providing a general revision of the tax code and instead passed a bill prepared by the joint committee on assessment and taxation which makes a few amendments to the present law.

These amendments provide for two payments, the first payment to be made April 15 and the second on October 15. The first payment is to be paid in full and the second in full or in part but not less than one-half the second payment, which is to be paid on or before the first of January.

Interest Provided For. When an annual payment is made in full it is not to be considered as a loan and interest will not be charged on it. In the event of the payment of the tax in two installments, the first being a loan, interest will be charged on the second payment.
