Oregon Trade Balance Mounts to \$578,000,000, Fast Liquidating Indebtedness.

Chicago.-The United States is now a creditor nation in the strict sense. The world is beginning to pay in cash for the immense volume of products

bought in this country. Gold is flowing steadily into the United States. Nearly \$41,000,060 has been received since January 1. Onefourth of this amount came in last week, and a continuous stream of the precious metal means ultimately the greatest era of prosperity this country
