GOLD RETURNS TO U. S.

Trade Balance Mounts to \$578,000,000, Fast Liquidating Indebtedness.

Chicago.—The United States is now a creditor nation in the strict sense. The world is beginning to pay in cash for the immense volume of products bought in this country.

Gold is flowing steadily into the United States. Nearly \$41,000,000 has been received since January 1. One-fourth of this amount came in last week, and a continuous stream of the precious metal means ultimately the greatest era of prosperity this country has ever known.

The trade balance in favor of the United States up to the close of business March 27 approximates \$578,000,000. This is the amount other countries owe the United States in excess of imports, however the difference may be settled. When the war began in August it was variously estimated that the United States was indebted to Europe even more than the present credit balance.

Food Conspiracy is Not Found.

Washington.—The department of justice announced that its agents, who have been investigating charges of "gouging" had found no evidence of conspiracy to increase food prices as a result of the European war.

AMERICAN REPLY IS SENT TO ENGLAND

Washington.—The reply of the United States government to the British order-in-council decreeing a virtual blockade against commerce to and from Germany was cabled to American Ambassador Page at London for presentation to the British foreign office. Beyond the fact that the United States stands firmly for its right to carry on legitimate trade with neutral countries, even though they be contiguous to belligerents, little is known of the administration's position.

Officials have pointed out, however, that the American government wanted more definite information as to the radius of action of the allies' blockading fleets, and that the question whether the order in council was to be enforced under international law governing blockades or under the rules of contraband, had not been answered.

Since efforts to bring about joint representations regarding the rights of neutrals on the high seas failed it is understood that the south and central American republics desire strongly to move along lines set by the United States to establish their record which will form the basis of claims for damages suffered by their citizens through the activities of the allied fleets.
