### Local Happenings.

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One of the 147 accidents reported to the state industrial accident commission during the week was fatal, and of the total reported, 91 were subject to the workmen's compensation act, 27 were from public utility corporations, 21 were from firms and corporations that have rejected the provisions of the act, and eight from other firms and corporations which do not employ labor in hazardous occupations. Sawmills led in the number of accidents, 31 being reported, while construction work was second with 28, railroad operations third with 13, and logging fourth with 12.
