Towns of County

Pacific City.

Pacific City, which is destined to become one of the most important summer resorts on the coast, has now a good hotel and general store, a saw mill is also located near this point where lumber for necessary construction work is manufactured. As a resort Pacific City offers not only sea shore attractions, but also river fishing and boating, being located on the beautiful Necanicum river, but a short distance from the mouth it is of easy access to all pleasures found on river bay and sea beach. Deep sea fishing, river fishing, and all kinds of shell fishing are enjoyed at this point. It is the sportsman's paradise and has splendid facilities for camping.

Broton Springs.

The Broton Springs which are located a few miles south of Cloverdale near the Little Nestucca Bay are under the management of H. H. Broton, who discovered these remarkable springs. Bath houses are located here and many remarkable cures have been made by Mr. Broton in the administering of the water from these springs and at the giving of the mud baths.

Hebo.

Hebo is located at the foot of Mt. Hebo, about three miles north of Cloverdale. Hebo is located a good general store, hotel, blacksmith shop, cheese factory, good school and a church.

Beaver.

"Yeh, she sure is some town!" This rightly deserved remark was passed by a well known Portlander the other day, who had just spent an enjoyable week in the thriving little city, sixteen miles due south of Tillamook. He gave a true and concise character sketch in those half dozen crisp words of the liveliest and most enterprising little city in the Nestucca Valley, widely known as Beaver.

Shielded from harsh sea winds by a protecting range to the westward, lying along the fertile banks of the Big Nestucca, under Mt. Hebo's mighty bulk—Beaver enjoys a climate unknown to the majority of Oregon Coast cities not so well protected from the elements by a tickle nature.

Second to none in her hunting and fishing resources, she is a mecca for the sportsman and campers the year round. Her fish laden streams and surrounding hunting reserves having a state wide reputation as matchless. These natural resources are greatly accentuated on account of their easy access by good roads and also by Beaver's excellent hotel and camping accommodations and her never failing civic hospitality.

Boasting, without a doubt probably the largest, most up-to-the-minute General Department store in the county, another first class Grocery and department store, two churches, a large and finely equipped school, two blacksmith shops, a large first class hotel, garage, livery barn, a spacious dancing pavilion, barber shops with billiard parlor in connection, a fine new loganberry dryer owned and operated by the influential Beaver Loganberry Association, a cheese factory and surrounded by some of the largest, most valuable and finely stocked ranches in the state, Beaver without a doubt will be a great prominent factor in making the name "Tillamook" stand for the greatest county in the greatest state in the great Northwest.

Wheeler.

The city of Wheeler which is located near the mouth of the Nehalem Bay on the South side of the Nehalem river is destined to become one of the most important lumber manufacturing points in Tillamook county and the Northwest. At present one of the largest mills on the Pacific Coast is located there, which, however, owing to the present conditions of the lumber market is idle. This mill has a capacity for cutting 150,000 feet in ten hours and when running at full

capacity employs 225 men in the mill and 50 in its woods. Wheeler also has another mill which has a capacity of cutting 20,000 feet in ten hours and is now running. Among other industries at Wheeler is a first class saw mill and an asphaltum plant.

Wheeler has a splendid first class hotel, good stores and business houses. The Nestucca Valley Bank under the management of J. A. Rowe, has always taken an active part in the development of the city and surrounding community.

Wheeler is depending to a considerable extent on the harbor improvements which are under way and which are fast nearing completion. A half million dollars are being spent on these improvements, which when completed will give Wheeler deep enough water to enable her mill to compete with any other mills on the coast.

Wheeler has a fine electric lighting system, good schools and churches.

Nehalem City.

The city of Nehalem is located on the north side of the Nehalem river with a splendid boat service to and from the railroad at Wheeler. It is also the nearest trading point to the famed and beautiful Nean-Kak-Nie resort.

Nestled at the foot of a range of hills, Nehalem has a splendid climate the year around, being protected from all the bad winds. As a trading point Nehalem has every advantage, nearly every line of business being represented with good stocks of goods. It has a fine hotel, Opera House, Newspaper, the Nehalem Times, a saw mill and box factory, a large salmon cannery and other smaller industries. Much of the land adjacent to Nehalem is fertile and at present productive, and Nehalem has just reason to believe that she will get her share of prosperity which will come when the Nehalem harbor improvements are completed and the timber of that locality begins to move.

Nehalem has a church and splendid schools, a fine high school being conducted there.

Mohler.

The village of Mohler is located south of Nehalem on the south bank of the Nehalem river in the midst of a splendid farming community. Mohler has a good general store, a fine cheese factory, church and school.

Brighton.

Brighton is located at the mouth of the Nehalem river. It has a good saw mill, general store, restaurant, etc.

Woods.

The little city of Woods is nestled among the hills on the bank of the Nestucca river. Dick Robedee, who conducts a general merchandising business is one of the oldest settlers of the county. The town of Woods has a good school, and is adjacent to some fine dairy lands. The county is about to build a fine new bridge over the Nestucca at this point which will be of great aid and assistance to this locality.

Bay City.

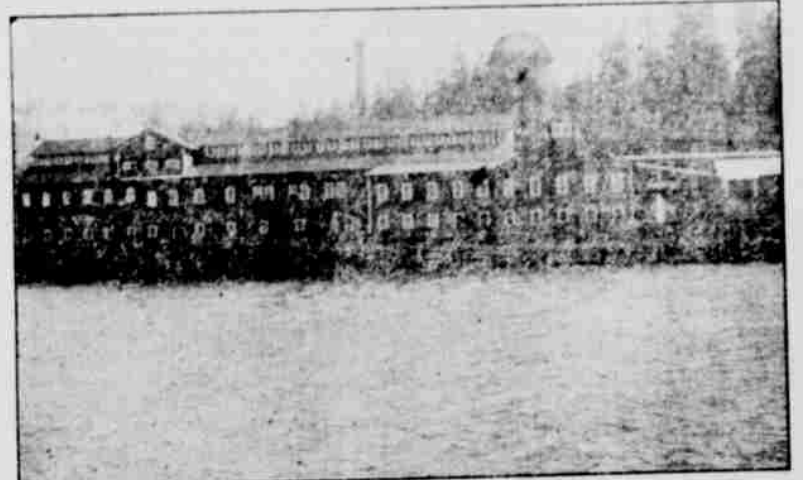
Bay City is located on Tillamook Bay, and has one of the most beautiful town sites.

It has two salmon canneries, an ice and cold storage plant for the handling of salmon and other fish, a saw mill and good electric lighting system. Bay City has now under construction several blocks of hard surface streets and is gradually assuming a modern and up-to-date appearance.

Bay City has a bank, fine hotel, opera house, several good stores, churches and splendid schools, including high school. With the completion of the harbor improvements now under way Bay City is anticipating a building boom and greatly increased activity along every line of endeavor.
