Report of road conditions as given out by the State Highway Commission Monday:

- Coast Highway
- Astoria-Seaside—Paved.
- Seaside-Tillamook—Open for travel gravelled or rocked.
- West Side Pacific Highway
- Portland-McMinnville—Paved.
- McMinnville-Amity, Rickreall, Mouth-Independence—Open except bridge over Yamhill river between McMinnville and Whitson which is being replaced. Traffic should detour from McMinnville via the McMinnville-Tillamook highway to a point five miles from McMinnville.

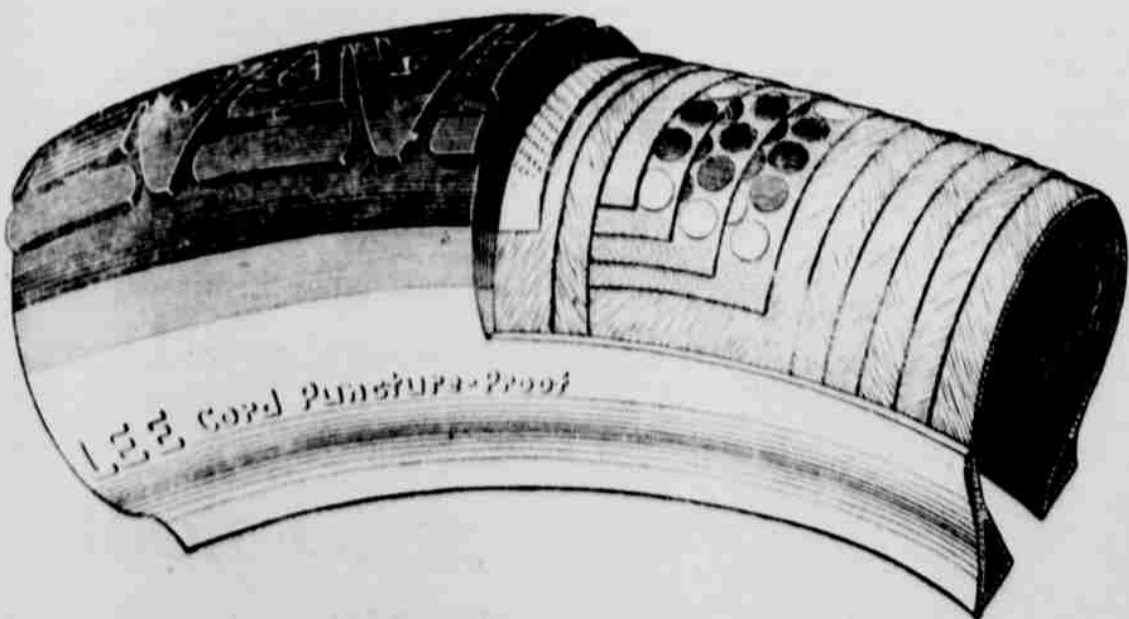
