Thomas J. Harris was born in Boone County, Missouri, on the 2nd October, 1833, and at the time of his death was 88 years, 6 months and 14 days old. In 1858 he crossed the plains on horse back, going to California, and in 1859 came to Oregon. In 1860 he was united in marriage to Miss Mary Elizabeth Smith, at Monmouth, Oregon. Here he obtained 160 acres of government land and engaged in farming. To this union were born eight children, four sons and four daughters, all of whom are living with the exception of one daughter. The children now living are: C. O. Harris of Sandlake, Mrs. Katoo Owens of McMinnville; and Jeff Harris, S. J. Harris, W. G. Harris, Mrs. Nancy Craven, Mrs. Lulla Robinson, all of Tillamook. It was 33 years ago that Mr. Harris and his wife and family moved to Tillamook county and located at Sandlake, and resided there continuously since he first came to the county. He took an active part in politics and in the development of the county in the early days of its history as a dairying section.
