The local editor, in proportion to his means, does more for his home town than any other ten men, and in fairness, man to man, ought to be supported, not because you like him or admire his writing but because a local paper is the best invest-

ment a community can make. It may not be brilliant or crowded with great thoughts but financially it is of more benefit to a community than a teacher or a preacher. Understand us, now, we do not mean morally or intellectually, but financially, and yet on the moral question you will find that a majority of the local papers are on the right side of the question. Today the editors of the local papers do most work for the least of any people living.—Somerton, Ariz., Star.
