Fire Fighter's Life Shown
In Spectacular "Third Alarm"

The entire workings of a big city fire department, from the time the first alarm is sounded until the big fire is completely extinguished, is graphically depicted in "The Third Alarm", which will be shown at the new Majestic Theatre in Vernonia on June 8 and 9. The sounding of the alarm, the method of procedure when the signal is heard at headquarters of a fire company, picturing the awakening of the men from slumber, their lightning like dressing and plunging down the perpendicular rod, the hitching of the horses and the mad dash out of the fire engine house is realistically portrayed. The attaching of the fire hose to the hydrants and the running of the hose to where it plays on the flames with engine pumping, scaling ladders ascending, axes swinging and flames hissing, all is presented in breath taking reality in "The Third Alarm".

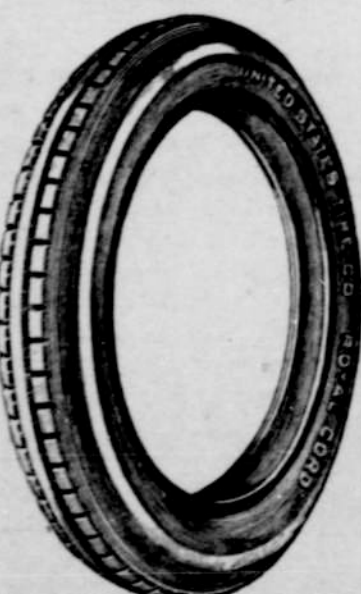
