

Fearful and Wonderful Mixture Which the Chinese Compound for the "Foreign Devil."

The ingredients of what the Chinese candidly call, in pidgin English, "lie" tea, are chiefly pulverized quartz, dry leaves, magnetic oxide of iron, and fine dark sand. Another form of "lie" tea is formed of about half genuine tea dust and the other half a mixture of magnetic oxide of iron and various powdered leaves of bamboo, willow and shrubs.
