Motors:
 Each horsepower of manufacturer's rated capacity shall be considered as 750 Watts. The combined rated capacity of all motors (except elevator motors) will be taken and the following percentages thereof considered as the demand.

Excess over 10 K.W. of total rated capacity	75%	70%	65%
In no case, however, shall average percentage be less than:	75%	70%	65%

Any motor or motors having a rated capacity less than ten per cent of that of the total installation shall not be considered as increasing the number of motors as applied under the above classification. Two or more motors having an aggregate rated capacity of ten per cent of the installation shall be considered as one motor.

Elevator Motors:
 All sizes, 70% of the normal running capacity.

Miscellaneous:
 The full rated capacity of all miscellaneous apparatus.

No demand to be established at less than 750 Watts.

Measured Demand:
 Any installation in excess of 20 K.W. aggregate rated capacity, or any special or unusual use of energy, may be measured, at the option of the consumer or the company.

Contract Form:
 For regular service see Regular Power Service Contract, subject to minor modifications to cover individual conditions.

The undersigned,, hereinafter called the consumer, hereby requests the Vernonia Light & Power Company, hereinafter called the company, to supply electric service to the premises:

The company agrees to furnish for the sole and exclusive use of the consumer, at the aforesaid address, electric service required or used during the period of this agreement, which commences on the date service hereunder begins as shown on the initial bill rendered by the company to the consumer, and continues for a term of

The consumer agrees to take and pay monthly for electric service furnished hereunder, in accordance with the terms and conditions, rates and minimum charges of the Company's Tariff for Residential and Commercial Lighting Service which are or may be in effect during the term of this agreement.

It is understood and agreed between the parties hereto that the consumer shall pay a minimum charge of \$..... per month for electric service hereunder, whether or not any electric energy was used. Five per cent discount will be allowed for payment of bills on or before the 10th day of the month next following the month in which service was rendered.

It is further agreed:

(1) That all bills for electric service shall be rendered by the company monthly and paid by the consumer at the office of the company on or before the 10th day of the month following, after which date the account shall be considered delinquent and service may be discontinued at the option of the company.

(2) The company shall have the right at any time to verify the demand occasioned by the consumer, either by measurement or by check of equipment connected to the company's distribution system. The company undertakes to provide equipment adequate to supply the consumer's initial installation only, but shall have the right to supply additional requirements of the consumer subject to the facilities and capacity of the company's system and to its tariffs and rules and regulations governing extensions. Before any change is made in the consumer's electrical equipment, the consumer shall notify the company, in writing, thereby giving the company opportunity to ascertain if any changes are necessary in its equipment or distribution system and to make such alterations in the charges for electric service hereunder as may be required by its tariffs for the altered conditions.

(3) Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the date service hereunder begins shall be the date service wires of the company are connected to the consumer's premises.

(4) Unless consumer begins to take service hereunder within three (3) months after date of execution of this agreement, the company may, at its option, cancel this agreement.

(5) At the expiration of the term hereof, or of any yearly period thereafter, this agreement may be terminated by either party, provided written notice is given at least thirty (30) days prior to such expiration. If not so terminated, this agreement shall continue in full force.

(6) This agreement is binding upon the company only when approved by an executive officer of the company, and shall not be modified or affected by any promise, agreement or representation by any agent or employee of the company, unless incorporated in writing into this agreement before such execution.

(7) This agreement and rates provided for herein shall be subject to all rules, regulations, orders or tariffs now or hereafter filed with, issued or approved by the Public Service Commission of Oregon.

(8) The company furnishes and installs a kilowatt hour meter or meters on the premises of the consumer at the point most convenient for the company's service, from the readings of which all bills shall be calculated. The company will keep an accurate account on its books of this consumption, which account shall be accepted as prima facie evidence of the consumption of the consumer. Should the meter fail to register, the consumption will be estimated from the amount used in a corresponding month.

(9) The company will not be liable for damages in case of interruption of service nor will such interruption constitute a breach of the contract for service.

(10) All meters, wires and other appliances installed by the company shall remain the property of the company. It is agreed that all wires and equipment upon the premises of the consumer, to which the company's distribution system shall be connected, shall be installed by the consumer at consumer's expense and in such manner that the company may conveniently perform its part of the agreement, and shall be under the control of and kept and maintained in proper condition by the consumer at consumer's expense. The company's inspectors may, at all reasonable hours, enter the consumer's premises on business connected with the installation and meters.

(11) The company does not assume the duty of inspecting the consumer's wiring and equipment, and shall not be responsible therefor. The use of said electric energy upon the premises of the consumer is at the risk of the consumer, and the liability of the company shall cease at the point of delivery of electric energy to the wiring or the equipment of the consumer. Unless otherwise specified in agreement, the point of delivery shall be the point where the company's wires or apparatus are connected with those of the consumer.

(12) This agreement shall be binding on the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, provided any such assignment by the consumer is accepted in writing by the company.

(13) This agreement supersedes all other between the parties hereto for electric service at the aforesaid premises.
