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NEW INTERNATIONAL APPEAL FOR REFUGEES

Geneva, Switzerland.—A joint appeal from twenty nations has been placed before the League of Nations, asking for the appointment of a commission to assist the American Near East Relief in its work for refugees in Greece and Bible Lands. The appeal says: "In view of the international character of the question involved and the necessity for an impartial, accurate and authoritative statement of the situation, we request the League of Nations to appoint a commission which shall make a prompt, thorough inquiry into the distressing conditions in the Near East and indicate what steps should be taken to ameliorate these conditions in accord with humanitarian views of our twentieth century life."

RELIEF WORK HEROINE BACK FROM NEAR EAST

Mrs. W. E. Rambo, a former resident of Chehalis, Klamath Falls and Baker, recently returned from the Near East.

She and her husband were singled out by the Queen of Greece for special thanks in connection with the rescue of fifty thousand Greeks in Batoum, following the World war. With her husband, she walked literally in the steps of the Apostle Paul as they took hundreds of children from a Turkish besieged village through Tarsus to safety on the Isle of Cyprus under the direction of the Near East Relief.

"We are familiar with suffering and even starvation," states Mrs. Rambo, "before we went to the Near East, for we spent our honeymoon in India in the midst of a great famine where hundreds of children were left at our very doors. With relief money sent from America we gave employment to hundreds of men who were thus able to support their families, and the buildings are in use today as orphanages."

"Our oldest son, Victor, returned a few weeks ago as medical missionary to the very spot where he was born, and he finds that the leaders in the community are the children whom we saved from death twenty-five years ago. With this experience back of us we naturally look for great results from Americans taking care of a hundred thousand children in the Near East."

Everybody takes a part in building a city. A big part in Vernonia is Ray Reasoner who has certainly scattered lots of gravel over the various streets, as well as furnished lots of it for buildings and walks. Mr. Reasoner has lots of it. Seen the opportunity and hastened to Vernonia to make his home.
