It is always a good idea to remember that the fellow who asks you how you feel today doesn't want to listen to a lot of symptoms.

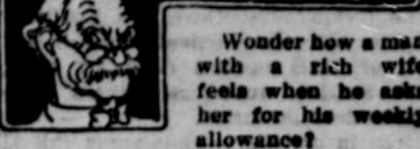
