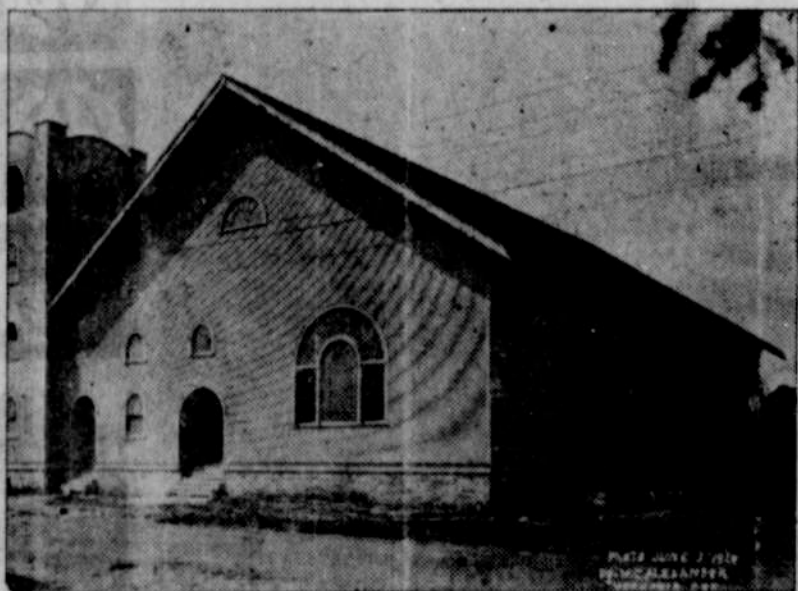

## Churches of Vernonia Have Large Congregations

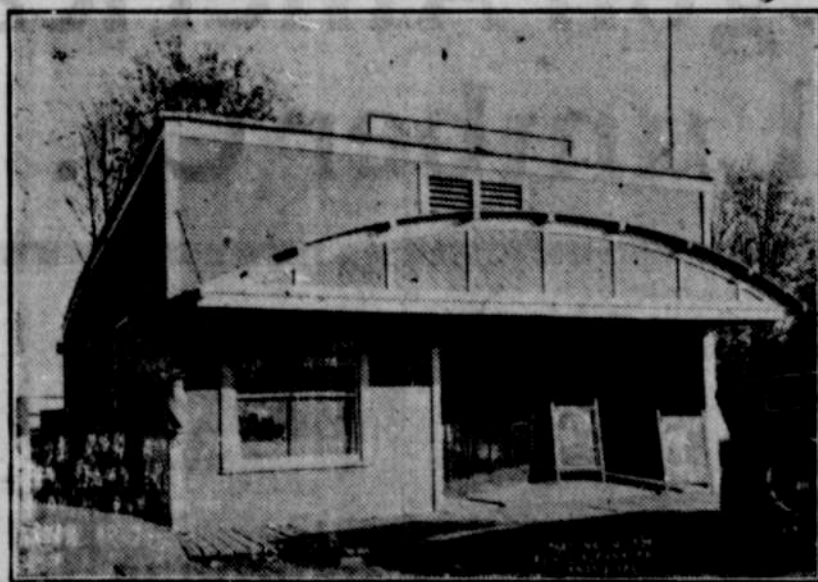
Vernonia as a town for worship is well graced with three churches.

### EVANGELICAL CHURCH



The Evangelical church, of which Wm. F. Rademacher is pastor, is located in the east central part of town. A large building constructed three years ago, offers large and ample space for its congregation.

### TEMPORARY BUILDING OF CHRISTIAN CHURCH



The Christian church, which is now using the building formerly occupied by the Rose theatre on Bridge street, of which, Rev. Curtis is now pastor, expects soon to have a new church completed, which they will be able to call their own. The old Christian church property was sold to other parties of Vernonia some time ago.

### CATHOLIC CHURCH



The Catholic church, Rev. Father J. P. Clancy, presiding, is located on the hill in the west part of town. On account of the pastor coming from St. Helens the services are held at different intervals. This church, though not old, has a large number of worshippers.
