

AIR MAIL BUSINESS SHOWS BIG GROWTH

The increase in use being made by Oregon citizens of their air mail facilities was revealed today in figures showing that they sent out a total of 186,311 pounds of sky correspondence in the first ten months of this year. This poundage is equivalent to almost seven and a half million letters, according to Postmaster E. F. Messing.

In the correspondence period of last year, 178,290 pounds of air mail was dispatched from Oregon points. Increasingly large gains are being shown each month, with faster schedules, the current rate of only six cents an ounce and a growing knowledge of the service offered as principal factors, Postmaster Messing said.

Under existing schedules, air mail from Oregon reaches California points overnight and the Atlantic coast with a loss of only one business day.

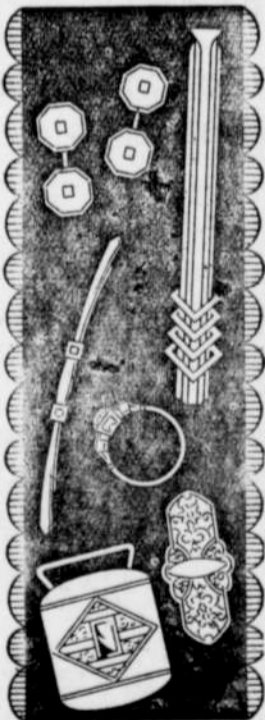
