Mrs. Judd Greenman is driving a new Lincoln Zephyr coupe.

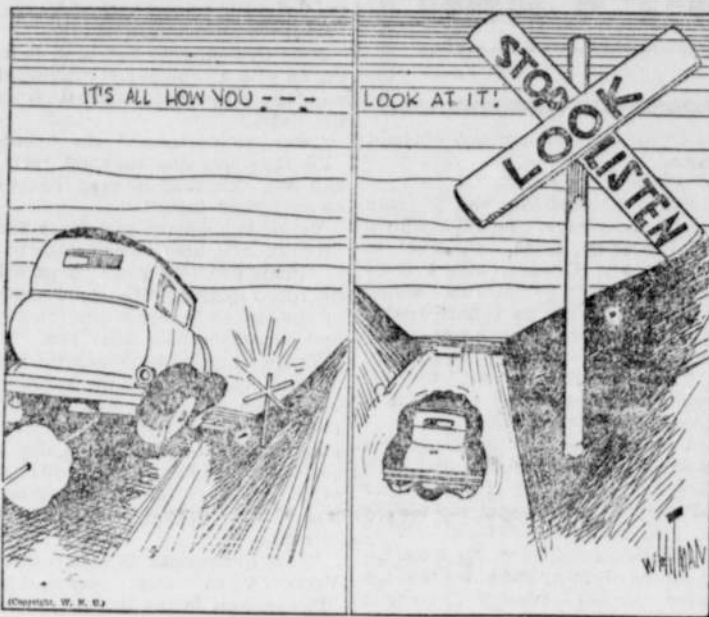

A Uni-Steel body as found in the 1937 Chevrolet, consists of separate sections assembled at the Factory and this assembly passed through a marvellous machine which welds all into one solid steel unit, without bolts, screws or rivets. This construction presents problems in the event of a wreck, to repair.

Wrecking such a body and repairing same, requires different methods than those employed in the old fashioned wood-steel construction.
