**NOTICE OF SCHOOL ELECTION UPON QUESTION OF INCREASING TAX LEVY OVER AMOUNT LIMITED BY SECTION II, ARTICLE XI, STATE CONSTITUTION**

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in School District No. 47 of Columbia County, State of Oregon, at The Washington School in said district, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said district the question of increasing the tax levy for the year 1937 over the amount limited by section II, article XI, of the Constitution of Oregon.

The reasons for increasing such levy are:

Due to a clerical error several years ago the clerk of this dis-

trict submitted the budget to the COUNTY ASSESSOR several thousand dollars lower than it had actually been voted. This error has subsequently lowered the base of this district so that it will be necessary to vote in excess of the 6 per cent limitation in order to carry on the school for the coming year.

The amount of tax, in excess of the 6 per cent limitation, proposed to be levied for said year is \$29,862.98.
