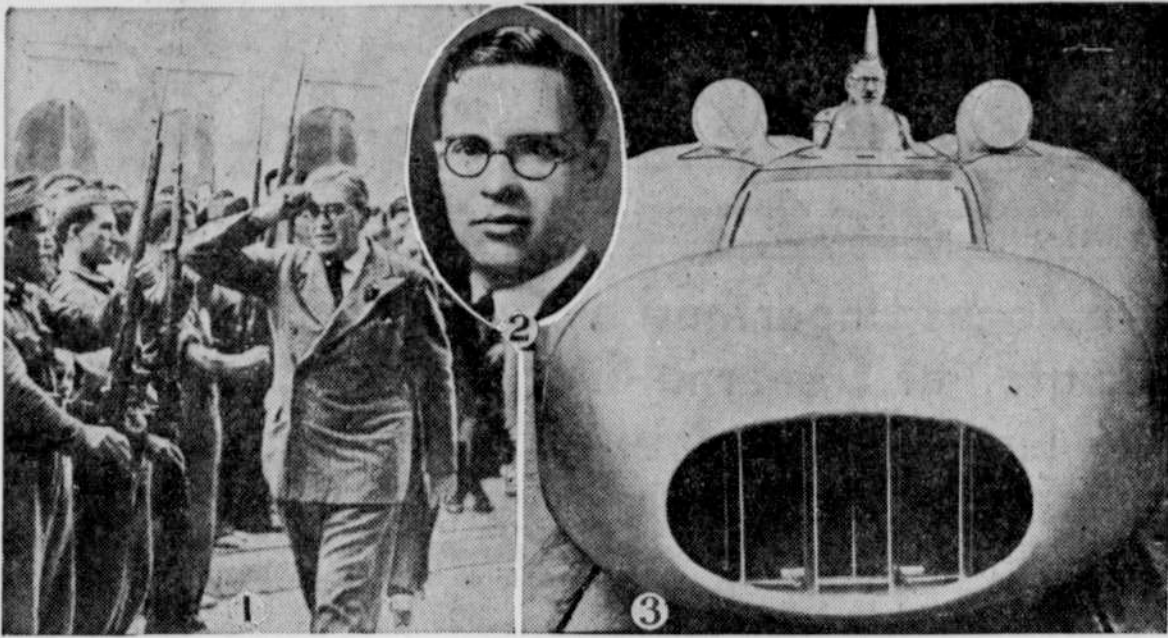

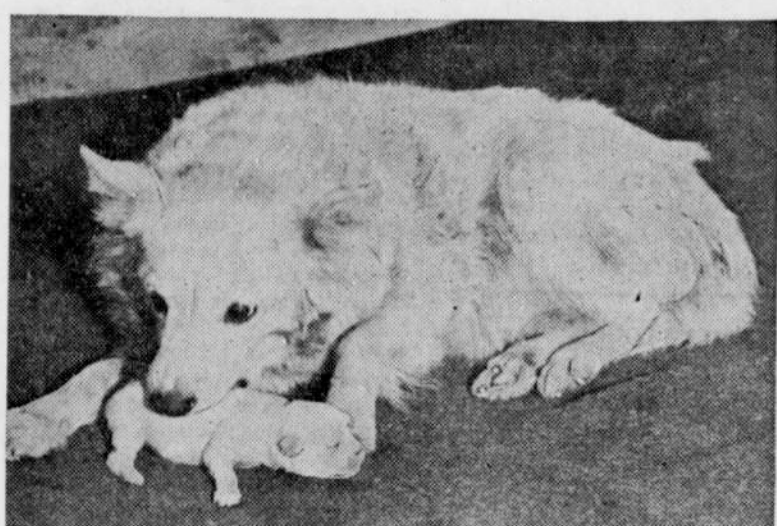

Evangelist, 78, Weds Pupil, 26



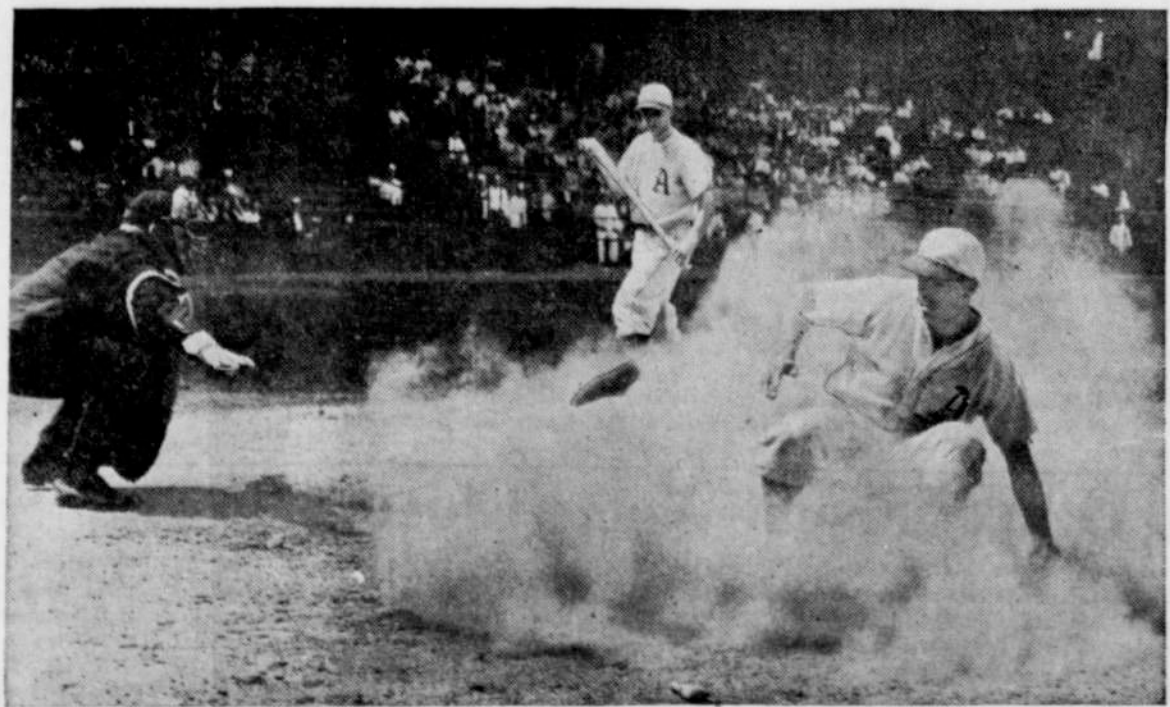
