Ryves Dates Chocolate Coeds, IWA Quintet Sunday, February 23

World Champion Basketball Team to Play at High School Gym

The Chocolate Coeds, world girl basketball champions, will play the IWA here Sunday afternoon at 2:30 at the high school gymnasium. Denny Ryves, IWA manager, announced Monday. The Coeds have become a national sport attraction due to the number of victories over other teams this season. Six girls comprise the team's roster of players:

Helen Smith is a graduate of Lemoyne college, Memphis, Tennessee and was featured at the Century of Progress at Chicago as the tallest girl in the world. Since Helen joined the coeds she has an all-time record of 1400 points for 81 games played and is rated as the best girl center in the world.

Kate Bard, forward, is a charter member of the coeds. She is a member of the current All-American team and has been picked the last four years by a majority of sports writers. Kate has never been held scoreless in 10 years of competition.

Bernice Marshall, known as "Midge" or "The Mighty Atom" due to her small size, comes from the famous Oberlin Coeds, CAU champs. Since joining the national champs she has reached the pinnacle as a scorer. She is always in the game and is really the spark-plug of the team.

Marge Jackson, known as "Stonewall Jackson" for her great defensive play, comes to the Coeds from Chicago U.

Lulu Porter, former grass court tennis champion and all-around girl athlete, is rounding out her fifth season with the champs. She is a great scorer.

Tyde Pickett, internationally known girl athlete, was a member of the U. S. Olympic team the last two times and had the unique distinction of meeting Herr Hitler. M's Pickett will tell about this meeting during half time. She will also give a hurdle and running exhibition.

The Coed team's record for this season is 37 victories against girl teams, 10 wins against men teams and 8 defeats.

Angling Rules Released

The 1941 angling seasons and bag limits regulations were passed recently by the Oregon State Game Commission. The rules affecting this area are listed as follows:

GENERAL OPEN SEASON FOR TROUT OVER SIX INCHES: April 12 to October 15, inclusive.

GENERAL BAG LIMIT FOR TROUT OVER SIX INCHES: 15 pounds and 1 fish but not to exceed 15 fish in any one day, or 30 pounds and 1 fish but not to exceed 30 fish in any seven consecutive days.

SALMON: 20 inches or over, open season entire year. Bag limit: 3 such fish in any 1 day but not to exceed 10 such fish in any 7 consecutive days, and it shall be unlawful to have more than 6 such fish in possession at any one time.

SALMON: 15 inches and over but less than 20 inches, open season entire year. Bag limit: 15 pounds and 1 fish but not to exceed 20 fish in any 1 day, or 30 pounds and 1 fish but not to exceed 40 fish in 7 consecutive days. This bag is to be counted with and as part of the trout bag limit.

SALMON: under 15 inches are classified as trout and may be taken only as such.

The above applies to all waters of the state of Oregon open to angling, including the Columbia river.

CLATSOP COUNTY
HUMBUG CREEK and its tributaries (tributary of the Nehalem river), closed to angling.

FISHHAWK CREEK and its tributaries (tributary of the Nehalem), closed to angling.

That part of the NEHALEM RIVER and its tributaries above and including WOLF CREEK, closed to angling.

COLUMBIA COUNTY
FISHHAWK CREEK and its tributaries (tributary of the Nehalem), closed to angling.

That part of the NEHALEM RIVER and its tributaries above and including WOLF CREEK, closed to angling.

OLD RANCH CREEK, closed to angling.

TIDE CREEK, closed to angling. All tributaries of ROCK CREEK, closed to angling.

All tributaries of CLATSKANIE RIVER above the mouth of Conyers creek, closed to angling.

All tributaries of BEAVER CREEK, tributary of the Clatskanie river, closed to angling.

That part of NORTH FORK OF SCAPPOOSE CREEK AND TRIBUTARIES above the Columbia river highway, closed to angling.

That part of MILTON CREEK between Taylor's dam and its source, closed to all angling to and including April 11, 1941, and from October 16, 1941 to April 11, 1942, both dates inclusive.

TILLAMOOK COUNTY
HEBO LAKE, open season for angling April 12 to June 15, both dates inclusive.

That portion of the TRASK RIVER from the head fish rack site near its confluence with Gold creek downstream to a point 200 feet below the lower rack, closed to angling.

All streams in Tillamook county closed to angling except: BIG NESTUCCA, LITTLE NESTUCCA RIVER, TRASK RIVER and its NORTH FORK, TILLAMOOK RIVER, MIAMI RIVER, NEHALEM RIVER, NORTH and SOUTH FORKS of NEHALEM RIVER, THREE RIVERS, SALMONBERRY RIVER, BEAVER CREEK, FOLEY CREEK, LAST CREEK, COAL CREEK, SALMON RIVER, SAND CREEK, NESKOWIN CREEK and that part of WILSON RIVER below its confluence with Jordan creek.

SAIN CREEK, tributary to

Scoggins creek, closed to angling.
CLEAR CREEK, tributary to Gales Creek, closed to angling.
That part of the NEHALEM RIVER and its tributaries above and including WOLF CREEK, closed to angling.
