

## Tags Authorized Mist Property By Drawing Fri. Transfer Made

No more applications will be accepted by the state game commission for tags to be issued for the special antlerless deer and elk hunts this fall since the applications received by the August 21 deadline exceeded the quota for all areas. Only a limited number of tags was authorized each area with successful applicants determined by drawing held at two o'clock, Friday afternoon, August 23, at the game commission office at 1634 S. W. Alder street Portland.

However, the general elk tag which may be purchased at any time from authorized license agencies, is good during the following seasons:

October 29 to November 14 in specified section of western Oregon; October 29 to November 20 in eastern Oregon; August 31, September 1 and 2 in Muddy Creek area of Baker county; November 21 to December 22 in specified portion of Baker county.
