Pension Raise

provided in new federal legislaerans in Oregon, a number of them in this community, Tom Craig, veterans administration representative here, stated Wednesday.

Under the same act, payment of full pensions or compensations to veterans being cared for in VA institutions will receive their full compensation, Craig added. These were limited previously to \$20 of their full monthly payments and in some cases to only \$8.

If institutional care extends beyond six months the payments may not exceed 50 per cent of the regular rate of \$30 a month, whichever is greater. Upon discharge from treatment, the veteran may receive a lump sum equal to that withheld after the six-month period.

First checks showing increases will not be issued before October 1, Craig said. He advised that, since pension increases will apply automatically, inquiries to the VA about them will accomplish little at present.

The. VA representative maintains office hours Wednesday mornings at the City hall in Vernonia, and encourages inquiries by veterans regarding other benefits offered by federal law.




