

## New Rules Set Aside Critical House Items

Director George E. Sandy of the Oregon department of veterans' affairs this week called attention to recent CPA regulations requiring distributors to set aside, for veteran purchase, such critical household, building and furnishing items as bath tubs,

kitchen sinks, lavatories, furnaces, in addition to items previously on the priorities list.

Sandy referred to "schedule B" to priorities regulation 33 which states: "Out of each shipment received by a distributor, he must set aside the percentage shown, and deliver those items only on rated orders." Further, "he must not deliver any items set aside on any unrated order, even if he does not have or receive any rated orders, unless he gets permission to do so."

"This changes the rule that used to apply to most of these items permitting them to be sold on unrated orders after they had been held a certain period of time," the regulations state.

The materials to be set aside, and the set-aside percentage, are listed as follows:

Bath tubs, 95 per cent; kitchen sinks, 75 per cent; lavatories, 90 per cent; water closets, tanks and bowls 90 per cent; cast iron soil pipe and fittings under five inches, 80 per cent; clay sewer pipe, four,

Ward Hoskins, Portland FHA priorities official, told Sandy that the above set-aside regulations are in addition to previous priority regulations which require dealers to honor priorities on 75 per cent of their stock, covering a long list of lumber, concrete, wiring, hardware, wall materials, and plumbing and heating supplies.

The difference between the new and the old schedules, Hoskins said, is that those items listed in Schedule B must be set aside by distributors and held until those with priorities for purchase actually apply. The old schedule, which remains in effect, specifies that the dealer may sell the items after a certain period of time to anybody, if priority holders have not requested those materials.

Priority applications should be mailed to the Federal Housing Administration, Platt building, Portland. The blanks may be obtained there, or from the department of veterans' affairs, or from county service officers. Five blanks are to be filled out, four to be sent to FHA and one for the applicant to keep. A delay of from 10 days to two or three weeks can be expected on approvals, according to Hoskins, who added that items on the set-aside list will be approved only for veterans either owning their homes or renting on long-term leases, and not to short-term renters or those in apartments.
