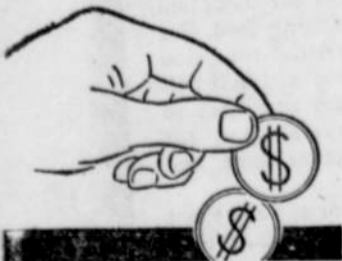

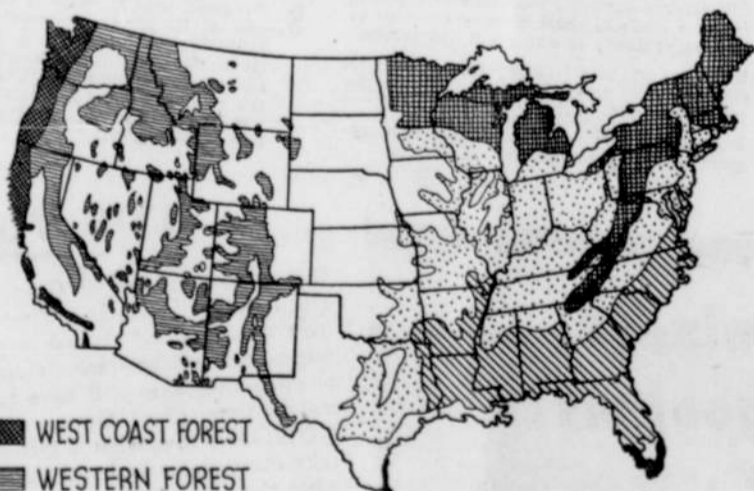

Cost of Living in Oregon

- Canned Peas: Accumulated 3% taxes, grower to consumer, 19.71c a dozen cans. Would such handicap to Oregon industry close up factories, reduce employment? YES.
