26 Specialties Open in Army

Twenty-six military specialties in the army security agency were announced to direct enlistments this week, according to Capt. Kenneth Swenson, army recruiting service. Individuals meeting the prescribed qualifications and who enlist for three-year periods will be considered for one of these technical ratings in the regular army.

The positions, which are divided into two categories—Administrative and Technical—are open to men of the white race; high intelligence scores and satisfactory qualifications in at least one occupational specialty must be attained by all applicants, the captain explained.

A complete list of technical positions available is as follows: Teletype Operator and Mechanic, Wire Chief, Voice Interceptor, Communications Chief, Radio Intelligence Control Chief, Telephone Switchboard Operator, Message Center Clerk and Chief, Traffic Analyst, Intermediate, High and Low speed Manual Radio Operators, Interceptor Operator, Cryptographic Repairman, Technician,

Code Compiler and Cryptanalysis Technician.

Administrative positions include Auto Mechanic, Translator, Heavy and Light Truck Drivers, Tabulating Machine Operator and Repairman, Clerk-typist and Administrative NCO. Training in certain of these specialties will be given at the Army Security Agency School, in Warrenton, Virginia.

Captain Swenson said knowledge of a foreign language is desirable but not essential in the case of men applying for Traffic Analyst or Cryptographic Code Compiler and Technician.

Interested young men are invited to visit the army recruiting station at Vernonia post office on Thursdays for complete details on any of the specialties offered qualified three-year enlistees in the regular army.
