**AROUND THE FARM** BY DON COIN WALROD County Extension Agent

Now that the strawberry season is about over we will have a chance to check production and see how many Columbia county growers are eligible for the Fiveton Strawberry Club. This club is sponsored primarily to increase yields per acre in Oregon and Southwest Washington strawberry producing areas. To be eligible to join the club, a grower must produce a minimum of 25 tons of strawberries with at least a five-ton average per acre. Average yield will be determined on a total producing

acreage basis and will include fresh market sales as well as sales to processors. The rules have been changed slightly this year so that a grower with less than five acres planted to strawberries can still be a member of the club. He must produce a minimum of 25 tons on his acreage though. Last year we had three growers qualify for membership. They were C. O. Johnson, I. A. Dacker and Morton Brothers, all of the Warren area. Hard luck has hit some of our

growers in this area and will lower yields considerably. Worst hit are growers in the area between Rainier and Clatskanie. A rot has developed that has taken from 75 to 90 per cent of their crop. This rot is a little different from the common rot caused by the wet weather. It hits the green berries that are held up away from the ground. Ralph Clark, Horticultural Specialist from Oregon State College, has taken some samples to the college to be analyzed. Mr. Clark was in our county last week making a survey of some newly planted strawberry fields. Many growers throughout Oregon lost from 50 to 90 per

cent of their new plantings this spring and the college is attempting to find the cause of their loss. After growers are checked, the findings will be made available so this situation will not be repeated. Certified plant growers have agreed to replace the plants that die. The practice of topping strawberry plants after harvest is followed by some growers in this area. Investigations have shown that this practice is quite effective in the control of crown moth (Crown borer.) Foliage must be removed soon after harvest so there will be time enough regrowth of

leaves to assure a good fruit set in the fall. A few rows or portions of rows should be left untopped so the crown moth will lay its eggs on these rows. If these plants are destroyed in late summer, a large portion of the infestation is thus removed. Except for the control of crown moth, the practice of topping is usually not the practical thing to do, however, some growers believe that later cultivation and control of weeds and runners is made easier by its use. Some growers in this area do not follow the practice because they feel it decreases the yield the following year.
