Mrs. Norman Hansen has been assisting in the store since Mrs. Howry has gone. She has worked for a long time when they needed extra help.

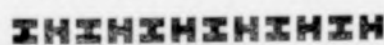
Highway Dept. Moves Change Familiar Patterns

The Clarence Kysers had their daughter and family from Clatskanie visiting here Sunday.

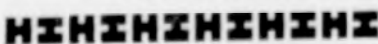
